

Warnings and safety information

Please pay attention to the safety and warning information provided in the operating instructions!

General safety precautions

- Make sure that no persons are in the danger zones of the machine.
- Before operating the machine, check that all safety devices are working properly.
- Read the operating instructions carefully and familiarize yourself with the safety precautions.
- Machines may only be operated when all safety devices are working properly.
- Always work within the approved power range (see technical data) and avoid overloading the machine.
- Only trained personnel should operate the machine.
- Maintenance and repair work must only be carried out by qualified personnel.
- Wear tight-fitting clothing and remove all objects that could get caught in the machine.
- Always disconnect the machine from the power supply before maintenance or repair.
- Make sure that no part of your body comes into contact with moving machine parts.
- Do not operate the machine under the influence of medication, drugs, alcohol or other substances that may impair your concentration.
- Use only original spare parts and accessories.
- Keep the work area tidy and clean to minimize potential hazards.
- In the event of malfunctions or noticeable faults, operation must be stopped immediately until the fault has been identified and rectified.
- Do not make any modifications to the machine.

Fire hazard

- Electrical equipment must not be extinguished with water. Use powder or halon extinguishers for this.
- Make sure that suitable extinguishers are available in the vicinity and that the operators are familiar with their use.
- Burning plastics can cause toxic emissions. Observe the general fire protection regulations.
- Keep suitable extinguishing agents available and prevent the spread of fire through sparks or glowing material.
- Make sure that no combustible materials are stored near the machine.



Electrical equipment

- The first connection to the power supply may only be carried out by qualified personnel, who will also check the proper functioning and the safety devices.
- The connection to the power supply must be carried out in accordance with the relevant regulations and protected against mechanical damage.
- The electrical equipment must comply with the applicable regulations and technical standards.
- Work on electrical equipment may only be carried out by appropriately qualified persons.
